IMPORTATION OF TELECOMMUNICATION/RADIOCOMMUNICATION DEVICES/EQUIPMENT INCLUDING SPARE PARTS THEREOF IN MAURITIUS

The ICTA hereby informs holders of a Dealer's Licence and the public at large that following the release of Telecommunication Directive 1 of 2009 and Telecommunication Directive 1 of 2010, the requirements detailed in the table below have to be fulfilled when importing and clearing telecommunication/radiocommunication devices including spare parts, either for sale or for personal use, from the MRA Customs Department.
