6. Bids will be opened in the Board Room of the ICT Authority's Office, on 27 May 2020 at 10.15 hrs (UTC) in the presence of bidders/bidders' representatives who may choose to attend.

7. Bidders/bidders' representatives attending the opening of the bids shall be required to adhere to the basic protective measures against the new coronavirus including the wearing of a mask.
