- 5. The deadline for submission of bids shall be on Wednesday, 27 May 2020 by 10:00 hrs (UTC) at latest. In the context of the pandemic COVID-19, in order to facilitate submission and evaluation of bids, the ICT Authority will accept proposal from bidders by <u>e-mail only</u>. - 6. Bids will be opened in the Board Room of the ICT Authority's Office, on 27 May 2020 at 10.15 hrs (UTC) in the presence of bidders/bidders' representatives who may choose to attend.
- 7. Bidders/bidders' representatives attending the opening of the bids shall be required to adhere to the basic protective measures against the new coronavirus including the wearing of a mask.
- 8. The ICT Authority reserves the right to: -
- (a) accept or reject any bid; and
- (b) annul the bidding process and reject all bids at any time prior to contract award as per provision of Section 39(1) of the Public Procurement Act 2006.
