COMMUNIQUE

Amendments to the Information and Communication Technologies (Licensing and Fees) Regulations 2003

The Information and Communication Technologies Authority (ICTA) wishes to inform its licence holders and the public of the amendments brought to Regulation 12 of the Information and Communication Technologies (Licensing and Fees) Regulations 2003 since the coming into force of the Information and Communication Technologies (Licensing and Fees) (Amendment) Regulations 2022 (Government Notice 180 of 2022).

The Amended Regulation 12 of the Information and Communication Technologies (Licensing and Fees) Regulations 2003 provides for the timeframe to submit applications for renewal of licences issued by the ICT Authority as follows:

- (i) Application for renewal of **Commercial Licences, including Dealers' Licences**, shall be made by the holder at least **6 months** before its expiry; and
- (ii) Application for renewal of **Engineering Licences**, shall be made by the holder at least **2 months** before expiry.

Applications for renewal which are not submitted within the prescribed period would be treated as new applications.
