## THE INFORMATION AND COMMUNICATION TECHNOLOGIES ACT

Regulations made by the Minister, after consultation with the Information and Communication Technologies Board, under section 48 of the Information and Communication Technologies Act

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Information and Communication Technologies (Clearance to Import ICT Equipment) (Amendment) Regulations 2022.
- 2. In these regulations -

"principal regulations" means the Information and Communication Technologies (Clearance to Import ICT Equipment) Regulations 2019.

- 3. The principal regulations are amended by inserting, after regulation 2, the following new regulation
  - **2A.** These regulations shall not apply to the Indian High Commission where it imports, on behalf of the Government of the Republic of Mauritius, an ICT equipment pursuant to the Memorandum of Understanding signed, on 11 March 2015, between the Government of the Republic of Mauritius and the Government of the Republic of India for the Improvement in Sea and Air Transportation Facilities at Agaléga.
- **4.** These regulations shall come into operation on 6 May 2022.
