Port-Louis: The Free Wi-Fi Zone project was officially launched in Rodrigues at Anse Quitor Community Centre on 29 June 2023. This event was held in the presence Mr. Alain Wong So, Commissioner for ICT in Rodrigues and Mr. Dick Ng Sui Wa, Chairman of the ICT Authority.

The event in Rodrigues is in line with the launching, by the Hon Pravind Kumar Jugnauth, Prime Minister, Minister of Defence, Home Affairs and External Communications, Minister for Rodrigues, Outer Islands and Territorial Integrity, of the 234 Free Wi-Fi Zone project which was held at Chamarel Village Hall on 27 May 2022.

Democratisation of access to the Internet to help bridge the digital divide

Under this project, the population in Rodrigues may now access free Internet in twenty-three (23) Wi-Fi Zones over the island.

With the aim of bridging the digital divide, the deployment and installation of Free Wi-Fi Zones in Rodrigues consonant with the Government's vision towards democratising access to the Internet for promoting economic development and social prosperity.

Through this project, inhabitants of Rodrigues will benefit free Wi-Fi service to stay connected and take advantage of online facilities to ease their daily lives.

The Universal Service Fund has been established and is managed by the ICT Authority pursuant to Sections 18 & 21 of the ICT Act.

Availability and accessing the Free WI-FI service

The Free Wi-Fi service is available 24 hours over 7 days a week and may be subject to the opening hours of certain sites. Each user will benefit from 2 hours of access per 24-hour period. To access the Free Wi-Fi service, select the 'ICTA Free Wifi' network. (see details on the attached video).
